



ALMIGHTY SILVER polished off the Tinchin Prince's Stakes field with a flourishing stretch run to win the 1 1/16th mile event contested over Aqueduct's inner track. The five-year-old gelded son of CATIENUS has now banked \$313,545 in 30-lifetime starts and sports an impressive career record of: 30-6-7-4! The Feb. 20th score was Almightly Silver's second consecutive victory during the month of February.

Almightly Silver was bred by Ken and Sarah Ramsey and is owned by the partnership of Randy Stasi and Giorgi Stable. As part of the lucrative New York Breeding and Racing Program's incentive awards, which rewards breeders, owners and stallion owners, the Ramseys will receive a 20% breeder's award of the winner's share of the \$60,000 purse (\$36,000) or \$7,200; and, as owners of CATIENUS will receive a 7% stallion owner's award of winner's purse or \$2,520 for a total awards payday of \$9,720!

CATIENUS, who has sired five Grade I performers on all surfaces, relocated to McMahon of Saratoga Thoroughbreds for the 2010 season and stands for a fee of \$10,000 live foal. The son of Storm Cat has cumulative progeny earnings exceeding \$18.5 million and is New York's only active sire with \$3 million in progeny earnings the last four years! With seven crops of racing age horses, which includes 45 two-year olds, CATIENUS has sired 20 stakes winners overall including two Grade I winners.
