

WHEELAWAY'S SLICK WILLIE EXPLODES THROUGH STRETCH RUN TO WIN FIRST TURF OUTING

SLICK WILLIE, making his first start over the turf in a state-bred NW-1X Allowance race going seven-furlongs at Belmont Park, exploded through the stretch to win his third lifetime start in 16th-career race. The dark bay four year-old gelded son of the McMahon-based Wheelaway went his final two furlongs in a very rapid 21.4 and stopped the race timer in a respectable 1:21.4. The explosive manner of his victory provides ample proof that he has a very promising future on the grass.

Bred by William Hettinger, Slick Willie is the third winner out of the 100% producing Housebuster mare Made For Eachother, whose second foal is the multiple stakes-placed Let's Fly Away (Wheelaway). The winning share of the purse (25,800) elevates Slick Willie's lifetime earnings to \$78,468 and qualifies Mr. Hettinger for a \$5,160 breeder's award from the New York Breeding and Racing Program.

For horses sired by registered New York based stallions, the breeder award is 20% of winner's share of the purse; and, for horses finishing second and third, breeder award is 10% of the earnings.

Wheelaway, a black type winner of 2-races, is the sire of 4-crops including 4-black type winners, and his progeny earnings exceed \$3.1-million.
