

ALMIGHTY SILVER charged from off the pace to take the lead at the sixteenth-pole and then dug in gamely to win a \$46,000 state-bred allowance race by a half-length. The mile and seventy-yard event was raced over Aqueduct's inner track which was listed as "muddy". The four year-old gelded son of the McMahon-based CATIENUS has now banked \$250,545 in his 27-race career.

Upon his arrival at McMahon of Saratoga Thoroughbreds Joe McMahon pointed out that CATIENUS has the ability to sire all types of runners stating: "He's a proven sire for all surfaces and distances".



With a trend toward racing homebreds, the Grade-I winning CATIENUS is well suited for the New York market. To date, the son of Storm Cat, out of the Mr. Prospector mare Diamond City has sired 20-stakes winners including three-time Grade I turf winner Precious Kitten (\$1,912,543) and juvenile Grade I dirt winner Dawn of War (\$409,489). Some of his other top earners include Cannonball (\$635,993), Talent Search (\$603,360) and Nolan's Cat (\$417,377).

With six-crops to race, Catienus has sired 20-stakes winners and 13-stakes placers and his overall progeny earnings exceed \$18-million.
